

## **QFR-SOU Initial Disclosure Statement** (section 557L)

Organisations must prepare an initial disclosure statement for the remuneration paid to the ten highest officers or board members of the organisation. The initial disclosure covers the period 1 July 2012 – 30 June 2013 and must be published one month from the commencement of Part 2 of the Amendment Act.

The initial disclosure statement must contain the following information:

- The remuneration paid to the ten highest paid officers in the organisation;
- The value of non-cash benefits given to an officer by the organisation other than remuneration; and
- Any amount paid to the officer in the officer's capacity as a board member. This does not include payments to the officer for the cost of travel and accommodation to attend board meetings. (Note: N/A for QFR-SOU)

Organisations must publish a copy of the initial financial disclosure statement as soon as practicable but no later than 5 business days after the end of the period within which the initial disclosure statement is required to be prepared under section 557M.
